Dear North Road resident

I am **Jean Brazil**, editor of the Audenshaw Rose newsletter and **Labour's candidate** in the local elections on Thursday 1st May. **I am writing to you concerning the problems you have been experiencing from the new school site.** Like you, I am demanding a fair deal from Tameside Council in order to resolve some of your concerns.

As North Road and your part of the Snipe estate has been used as a temporary route for construction vehicles with heavy vehicles routinely accessing the new school site, to make deliveries of equipment and building materials, **I very much understand that this has caused you and other residents considerable disruption and inconvenience.**

I believe that, you, as local residents have had to put up with a lot. While the new school is brilliant news for Audenshaw's children and parents, the disturbance to residents during the construction phase has been considerable and extremely problematic. **I have picked up on these concerns during my recent walkabouts** and **I agree with you** that your concerns need to be both listened to and acted upon.

I will be working closely with Andrew Gwynne MP, Audenshaw's Member of Parliament, in **seeking assurances** that once the construction of the new school has been completed **the road and pavements are reinstated back to a good condition.** I also want to ensure that an open green area and public footpath, which was dug up to create a temporary access road, is fully restored to its original condition.

I think it is the very least the Council should do given the substantial inconvenience and damage to the road which has been caused by this project.

If you want to discuss issues further, please feel free to contact me on the details given above. I can't make promises, just reassurances that **I am on your side** and doing all I can to get your very real problems recognised and resolved by the Council.
